What An Exciting Few Months...

We are pleased to report that we are currently serving 91 classrooms in Monterey County for the 2024/2025 school year. With five additional classes in Tehama County, our total impact has grown to an impressive 96 classrooms—a 35% increase over last year!

In Monterey County alone we are reaching more than 3,500 students and siblings in King City, Greenfield and Salinas. By coaching students on The 9 Best Ways to Read to Young Children and providing specially curated books for them to regularly read to their preschool-aged siblings, Read to Me Project is helping little ones develop crucial pre-literacy skills and a love for reading, while older students improve their own reading fluency—and have fun in the process!

We offered our class for teen parents again this fall through South Monterey County Joint Union High School District and are exploring further collaborations for our parent education classes in King City and Salinas.



Community Connections - Ohana

Read to Me Project was invited to lead a class for dads at Ohana last month. Organizers and participants deemed it such a success that Read to Me Project will conduct another class this week.

"We had an incredible evening with nine dedicated dads at Ohana, all of whom are diving into the journey of early literacy with their children under the age of three. The group engaged fully with the discussion on the impact of reading at this stage, sharing experiences and supporting each other's growth. The positive energy and strong outcomes from the session have already led to an invitation to return! The evening highlighted how meaningful these sessions are for dads, with some expressing how books have transformed not only their children's lives but their own as well. The lasting value of early literacy engagement continues to shine through this new initiative, and we're excited to see where these sessions lead."
